Sunset and Sunday masses will resume on **14 March (Saturday)** and **15 March (Sunday)** when all the churches put in place the necessary precautionary measures. The resumption of Masses is subject to prevailing MOH guidelines and advisories. Whilst the necessary precautions have been put in place, for those who do not wish to take the risk, you are exempt from attending Mass to fulfil the Sunday Obligation. Instead, this obligation can be fulfilled by participating in the online Mass or spending time in prayer, reading and reflecting on the recommended scripture readings for the day. As part of measures to optimise public safety and your safety during this period of COVID-19 (coronavirus) outbreak, **YOU MUST COMPLETE A CONTACT TRACING FORM EVERY TIME YOU ATTEND MASS.** This allows the Ministry of Health to contact you in the event of a COVID-19 case happening in this church.

All we need are your full name, contact number and where you are seated/standing.*

If you are standing at the back or the sides, fill in the pew number that is nearest to you.

Exception: Families

We understand it is troublesome for families attending Mass together to submit multiple forms, so for those:

- Attending Mass as a family and are **seated/standing together**, we only need 1 **representative** to complete the form on behalf of the whole family to account for how many family members are seated/standing together.
- Attending Mass as a family but are **seated/standing separately** (e.g. in different pews), we need 1 **representative** from each pew to complete the form and account for how many family members are seated/standing with you. (A parent or elder sibling to complete the form)

The idea is that if we need to contact-trace, getting in touch with 1 representative from the family allows us to get in touch with the rest of the family. Therefore, please give us your full name (and not your initials or alias) and correct contact number so that we can get in touch with you / your family quickly.

For those attending Mass as a group (but are not family):

Those attending Mass as a group (e.g. friends, ministries, girlfriend/boyfriend etc) - **pls fill in the form individually.**

How to fill in the Contact Tracing Forms?

There are 3 ways you can fill in the Contact Tracing Forms.

1. By scanning the QR code that you see on your pew
 - Go to the camera function on your phone and focus your camera on the QR code
 - It will take you to an online form
2. By using the URL
 - If you are unable to use the QR code, you can type the URL (printed in Red below the QR code) into your phone browser (Safari, Chrome etc)
 - It will take you to the same online form
3. By filling in the paper form
 - If you need a paper form, raise your hand. Wardens/volunteers will pass you a form & pencil (or pen). If you can, please use your own pen or pencil.
 - Those using paper form, pls also indicate the date and time of Mass you are attending.
 - Wardens/volunteers will collect it back once you are done.
 - Wardens should sanitize their hands before and after this exercise.

Temperature screening will also be in place. Please come early for Mass and follow the instructions given by the wardens. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.
